GED[®] credentials are securely issued electronically to eliminate document tampering, fraud, and enable processing and distribution of credentials. GED Testing Service[®] has partnered with Parchment to launch GED Credentialing[®], an electronic credentialing service that easily and securely allows test-takers and institutions to request credentials. GED Credentialing[®] uses patented Blue-Ribbon technology certifying the validity and assurance of the issued document. Institutions and organizations do not separately need a credential verification from GED Testing Service[®] because the technology detects document tampering and confirms document authenticity. Paper credentials are available, if necessary, and contain multiple security features to prevent unauthorized duplication.
